

## ILLEGAL ALIENS & CRIME

1. Illegal Aliens accounted for 21.8% of all sentenced felonies in Maricopa County Superior Court in 2007.
2. Illegal Aliens comprised 21% of all inmates in the Maricopa County Jail system in February of 2008.
3. Criminal Aliens comprised 27% of the Federal prison system in 2003.
4. A study population of 55,322 Illegal Aliens showed they committed 700,000 crimes.
5. In September of 2009, criminal aliens accounted for 15.4% of all Arizona Department of Corrections inmates.

## ILLEGAL ALIENS & CRIME CONT.

6. As of January 4, 2010 the State of Arizona is owed more than \$1 billion by the Federal Government for uncompensated costs of incarcerating Illegal Aliens.

## ILLEGAL ALIENS & EDUCATION

1. In 2004, Arizona spent \$540 million on English Language Learner students.
2. In 2009, Arizona spent nearly \$1.4 billion on K-12 education for Illegal Alien children and children of Illegal Alien parents.

## ILLEGAL ALIENS & TAXES

1. The Congressional Budget Office determined the tax revenue generated by Illegal Aliens does not offset the total cost of services provided to them.

## ILLEGAL ALIENS & WAGES

1. Illegal Aliens have depressed the overall wages in Arizona by \$1.4 billion.

1. As of January 2010, 470,000 Illegal Aliens were living in Arizona.
2. As of January 2009, 460,000 Illegal Aliens were living in Arizona.
3. As of January 2008, 560,000 Illegal Aliens were living in Arizona.
4. As of January 2007, 530,000 Illegal Aliens were living in Arizona.
5. As of January 2006, 500,000 Illegal Aliens were living in Arizona.

## LEGAL PERMANENT RESIDENTS IN U.S. BY YEAR.

1. In 2009, 1,130,818 immigrants were admitted.
2. In 2008, 1,107,126 immigrants were admitted.
3. In 2007, 1,052,415 immigrants were admitted.
4. In 2006, 1,266,129 immigrants were admitted.
5. In 2005, 1,122,257 immigrants were admitted.

## ILLEGAL ALIENS & HEALTHCARE

1. In 2000, border county hospitals incurred \$190 million in uncompensated care due to treating Illegal Aliens.
2. Illegal Immigration cost AZ \$594.8 million in Medicaid and SCHIP funding in 2009.

## IMMIGRANT OVERSTAYS

1. For the years 2007, 2008 & 2009, at least 300,000 persons nationally overstayed their visas in each of those years.
2. As of 2000, 2.3 million persons nationally overstayed their visas.
3. As of 2006, 45% of the Illegal Alien population nationally entered legally and then overstayed their visas.

## IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS BY YEAR

1. In 2009, DHS apprehended 613,000 foreign nationals; 86% were natives of Mexico.
2. In 2008, DHS apprehended 792,000 foreign nationals; 88% were natives of Mexico.
3. In 2007, DHS apprehended nearly 961,000 foreign nationals. Nearly 89% were natives of Mexico.
4. In 2006, DHS apprehended more than 1,206,000 foreign nationals. Nearly 88% were natives of Mexico.
5. In 2006, DHS apprehended more than 1,291,000 foreign nationals. 85% were natives of Mexico.
